

Garage Sale Rules and Regulations

No garage sale shall be conducted for more than three (3) consecutive Days or more often than once each quarter.

No items offered for sale shall be displayed within the village street or sidewalk right-of-way or obstruct the normal flow of vehicles or pedestrian traffic.

Garage sale signs shall not exceed six (6) square feet per side.

Garage sale signs must be freestanding and not attached to any tree, utility pole, building or other structures.

Garage sale signs shall not be placed in any public right-of-way or public easement (area between the sidewalk and the street).

The top of the garage sale sign shall be no more than two and one-half (2 ½) feet from the ground.

Signs may only be placed on locations other than the sale premises with written permission of the owner. Written permission must be provided to the village prior to sign placement.

Signs shall contain the name of the owner, address of the sale, and the dates of the sale.

All garage sale signs must be constructed of job material suitable for display and safety, and all letters or numbers (except name, address, and dates of the sale) shall be in minimum of three (3) inches high.

Garage sale signs not in compliance with these rules and regulations are subject to removal and disposal.
